COVID-19 Update #5

ST. GEORGE – With ongoing efforts to “return to normalcy” and with the Province remaining in the “Phase Yellow” state, the Town of St. George has reopened more recreation areas: the basketball court and baseball field have reopened. Any organized sports groups looking to use the courts or fields must contact the Town Hall and prepare an Operational Plan.

Please note that all playgrounds are open however equipment is no longer sanitized regularly at this time (as per province guidelines). Users should wash hands before/after use and practise social distancing.

In addition, as of June 6, Canal Beach open on time for the season.

The St. George Public Library has re-opened, with controls, on each Thursday, 1-4pm.

Meetings of Council will continue to be conducted over video conference. Please check out meeting agendas for details or call the Town Hall for more info.

In April, Council has declared a number of events cancelled:

- Canada Day events are cancelled.
- Summer Concert Series (Thursday evenings, July-August) is cancelled.
- SummerFest (scheduled for July 17-19) is cancelled.

The following are current situations within the Town of St. George:

- The Town Hall is limited to the public. Water & Sewage payments are being accepted.
- The Fire Hall is closed to all, unless there is an active fire call, then only fire fighter members are permitted in the fire hall.
- All water and waste water (sewage) services continue uninterrupted.
- Trash and Recycling collection continues as scheduled.
- The Magaguadavic Place Civic Center is limited access for public rentals; YMCA Day Camp is schedule to open over the next week.
- A number of businesses in the town have altered hours of operation and have controls in place to help protect customers and employees.
