



BY-LAW NO. 85-1-2020
AN AMENDMENT BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ST. GEORGE
GARBAGE & RECYCLABLES COLLECTION

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of St. George under the authority vested in it by the Local Governance Act, R.S.N.B. 2017, c. 18, amendment of the following (in bold and italic):

DEFINITIONS

1. In this By-Law, unless context otherwise requires,

"bins" is a *private use* waste container for temporarily storing waste, and is usually made out of metal or plastic.

"receptacle" means a bin or can, of no more than *250 litres/55 gallons* in size, used to contain public garbage, may be referred to as a *public* garbage can.

GARBAGE BINS

12. In addition to Section 8, garbage bins constructed of wood must be painted or treated/stained.

a. shall not exceed a total volume of 360 litres/80 gallons.


