

BY-LAW NO. 84 A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ST. GEORGE RESPECTING THE REMUNERATION OF FIREFIGHTERS

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of St. George under the authority vested in it by the Local Governance Act, R.S.N.B. 2017, c. 18, as follows:

DEFINITIONS

1. In this By-Law, unless context otherwise requires,

"Call" means the fire call, alarm or request for response,

"**Driver**" is a designated person who will be responsible for being the primary driver of a fire-fighting vehicle during a scheduled period of time, and will also be responsible for cleanliness of hall and trucks during the scheduled period to time,

"Fire Chief" means the Fire Chief of the Town of St. George,

"Fire Department" means the St. George Fire Department for the Town of St. George,

"Firefighter" means any volunteer, temporary or permanent firefighter of the Town of St. George,

RATES

- 2. The salaries for the Fire Chief and the Deputy Fire Chief per year shall be:
 - a. \$12,250.00 for the Fire Chief
 - b. \$5,530.00 for the Deputy Fire Chief
- 3. A Driver shall be reimbursed, per each weekend day, and Statutory Holiday for the Province of New Brunswick, of being on-call, at a rate of:
 - a. \$125.20
- 4. The rate of pay for each call shall be:
 - a. \$24.45

OTHER

- 5. All officers and firefighters are deemed volunteers, and as such, are not entitled to benefits or agreements of a staff member of the Town of St. George.
- 6. Salaries and payments shall be paid on the final pay week of each monthly.
- 7. Salaries will be increased each year at a rate of 2%.
