## BY-LAW NO. Z.2.4

## A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. Z.2, BEING THE RURAL PLAN FOR THE VILLAGE OF BLACKS HARBOUR

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Council for Eastern Charlotte as follows:

1. By-law No. Z.2, the Rural Plan for the Village of Blacks Harbour, is amended by repealing the proposal in section 6.2(1) and replacing it with the following:

To establish a Commercial Zone that would permit appropriate commercial uses (such as retail shops and restaurants) with a mix of residential uses that are complementary to the development of the Village Center's commercial character around Main Street.

- 2. By-law No. Z.2, the Rural Plan for the Village of Blacks Harbour, is amended by repealing section 22.1(1)(k) and replacing it with the following:
  - (k) a single family dwelling, two family dwelling, or multiple unit dwelling, that is located above a commercial use on the ground floor area in a main building, or, as a standalone residential use pursuant to section 22.5(1)(b).
- 3. By-law No. Z.2, the Rural Plan for the Village of Blacks Harbour, is amended by repealing section 22.5(1)(b) and replacing it with the following:
  - (b) where the *use* is located closer than 10 meters from the *street line* of Main Street and the *ground floor area* of the *use* is not a *commercial use*.
