BY-LAW NO. Z.2.5

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. Z.2, BEING THE RURAL PLAN FOR THE VILLAGE OF BLACKS HARBOUR

BE IT ENACTED by the Council for Eastern Charlotte as follows:

1. By-law No. Z.2, the Rural Plan for the Village of Blacks Harbour, is amended by amending Section 5.2.3(3) to read as follows:

"Multiple-unit dwellings may be subject to terms and conditions established by the Planning Advisory Committee, or by Council at the time of a rezoning:"

2. By-law No. Z.2, the Rural Plan for the Village of Blacks Harbour, is amended by amending Section 19.2 to read as follows:

"One of the following main *uses* may be permitted subject to terms and conditions established by the Planning Advisory Committee, or by Council at the time of a rezoning:

- (a) multiple-unit dwelling; or
- (b) bed and breakfast establishment."
- **3.** By-law No. Z.2, the Rural Plan for the Village of Blacks Harbour, is amended by changing the zone as shown on the Zoning Map attached to the said By-law as Schedule "A" thereof for the lands shown on Schedule "1" attached hereto and forming part hereof from SINGLE & TWO FAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONE (R-1) to SINGLE, TWO & MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONE (R-2)


