

Parks & Recreation Recreation Operator/Labourer

JOB SUMMARY:

The Municipality of Eastern Charlotte has an opening within its Department of Parks & Recreation for one (1) full-time Recreation Operator/Labourer

A Recreation Labourer/Operator works as part of a team and provides recreation services to the larger Eastern Charlotte and its residents. These services include the operation and maintenance of the Eastern Charlotte Recreation Complex in Blacks Harbour, a Splash Pad in St. George, as well as Canal Beach, 2-3 baseball fields, tennis & pickleball courts, 2 outdoor basketball court, skate park, 4-5 playgrounds, 2 community gardens and walking trails throughout Eastern Charlotte.

Monday-Friday, 8:00-4:30pm Shift Work in Winter/Arena Schedule Overtime as required.

KEY DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for conducting general maintenance functions
- Operation and maintenance of Arena & ice surface, within an ice plant
- Cutting grass on sports fields
- Cutting, trimming and chipping trees
- Equipment repair and maintenance
- Directing traffic & Event management
- Work in compliance with all Occupational Health and Safety and Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System regulations
- Other duties as assigned

> Arena Operations

- Annual start-up and shut-down of ice plant
- Regular maintenance of ice plant; flooding of ice surface and ice removal
- Monitoring of plant functions, record-keeping and log maintenance
- User scheduling, as requested
- Daily inspection of electrical room and plant room, ice surface, glass and building for problems and/or hazards and maintain building in clean condition
- Visual inspections of inside and outside areas, including parking lot, to ensure hazards do not exist
- Reporting identified problems and/or hazards to the Foreman in a timely manner.
- Painting & general repairs (wood, metal)
- Assist Foreman in ordering supplies & booking inspections
- Maintenance & cleaning of Eastern Charlotte Recreation Complex activity area & upstairs

Recreation Operations

- Maintain and repair municipal baseball & sports fields
- Canal Beach maintenance & repair
- Splash Pad maintenance & repair
- Maintain and repair municipal parks
- User scheduling, as required

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Grade 12 diploma or equivalent
- Working knowledge of the operation of a variety of trucks, yard equipment
- 2 to 4 years' experience in sports and recreation maintenance and/or programming
- A valid New Brunswick Driver's License (Class 5) is required; an airbrake endorsement (Class 5e) would be considered an asset

ADDITIONAL SKILLS

- Strong communication skills
- Ability to deal with the public and respond to inquiries in a tactful and courteous manner
- Working knowledge of sports/creation play areas (baseball fields, ice hockey arena, etc.)
- Basic knowledge of computers/technology
- Working knowledge of all Occupational Health and Safety and Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System regulations
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Certification in Arena Maintenance would be considered an asset
- Willingness to complete the East Coast Arena Training (ECAT) and Turf Management and Maintenance Course via Recreation NB
